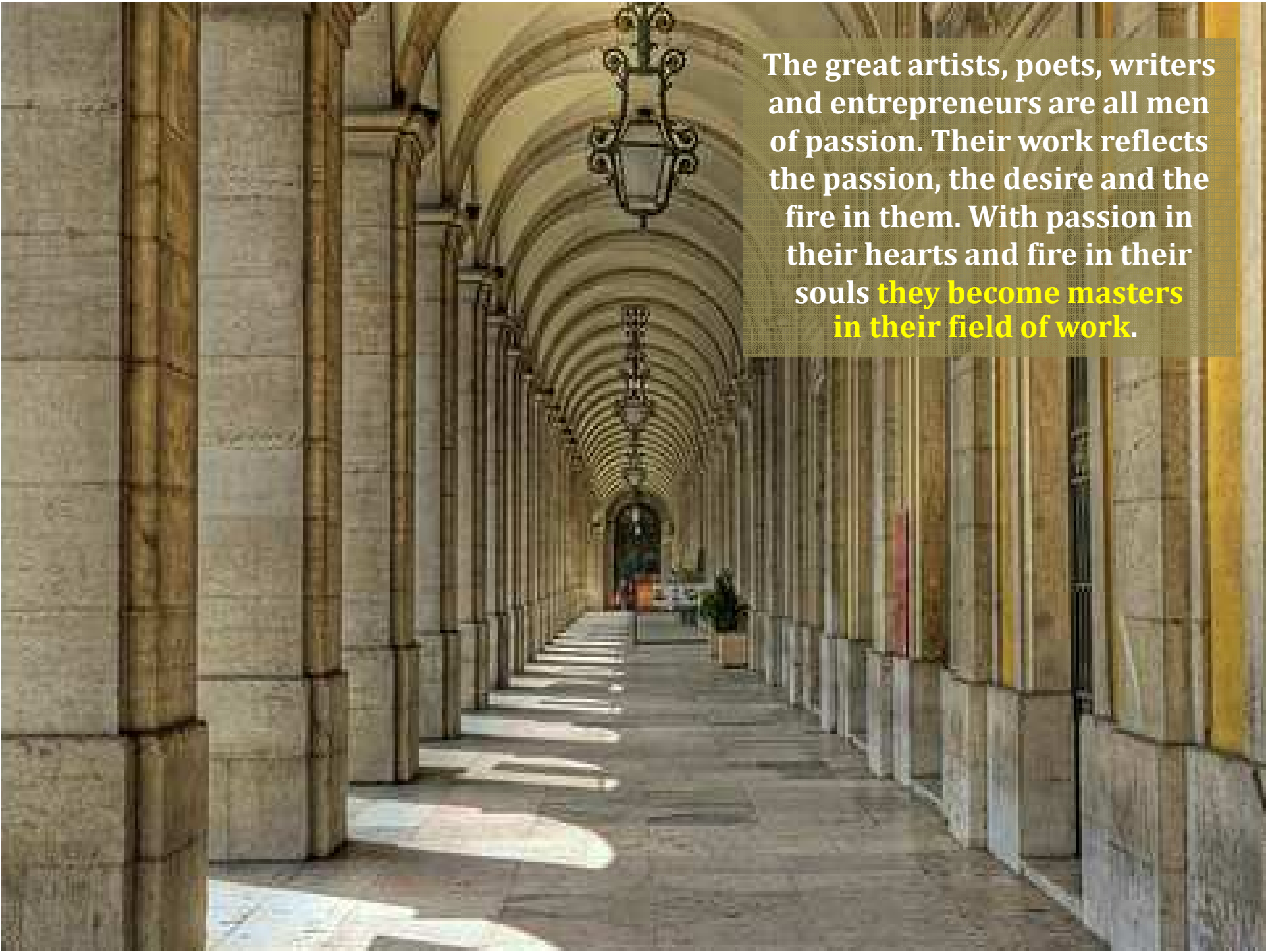




Find Your Passion

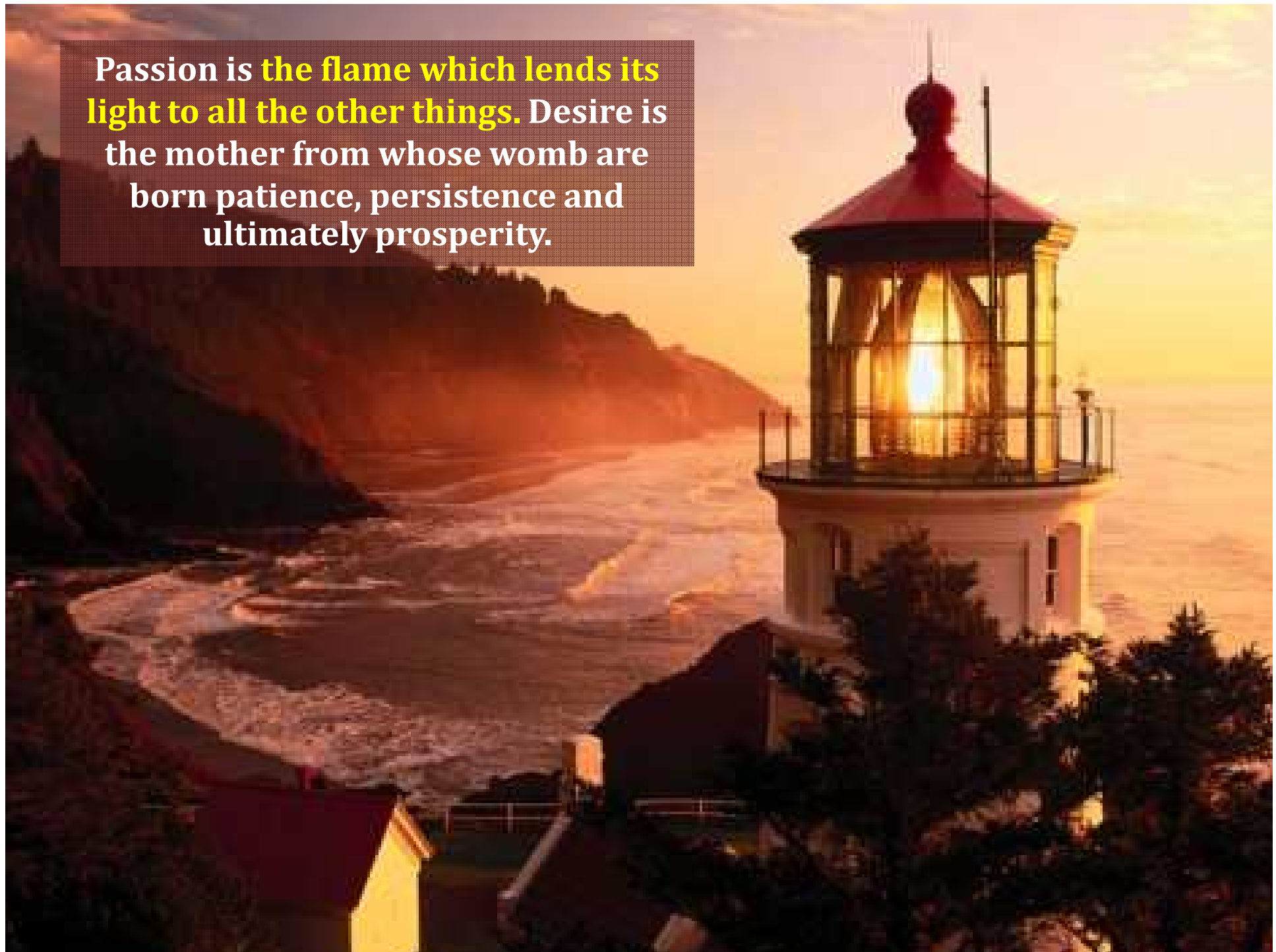

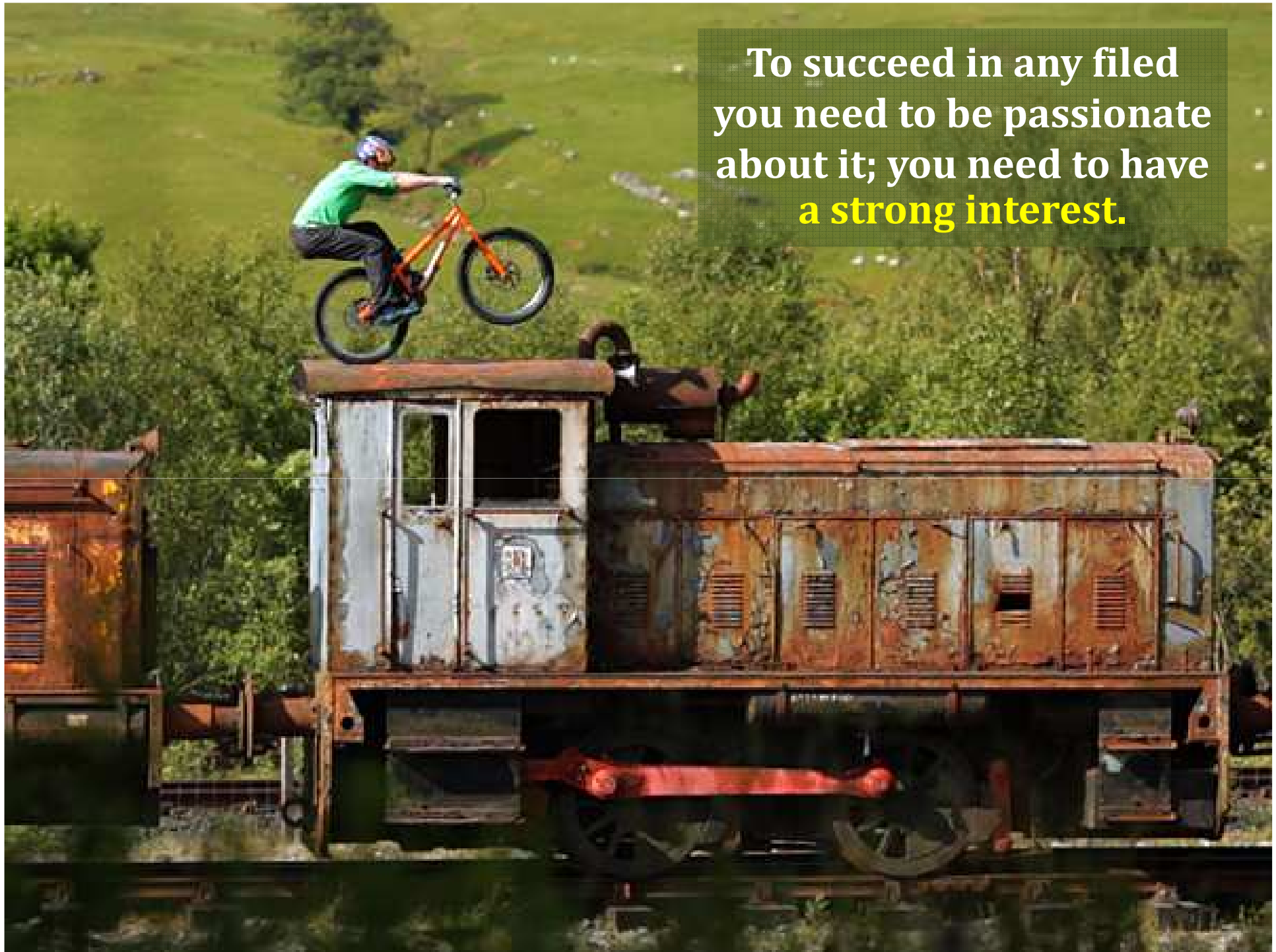

Passion is **the flame which lends its light to all the other things.** Desire is the mother from whose womb are born patience, persistence and ultimately prosperity.

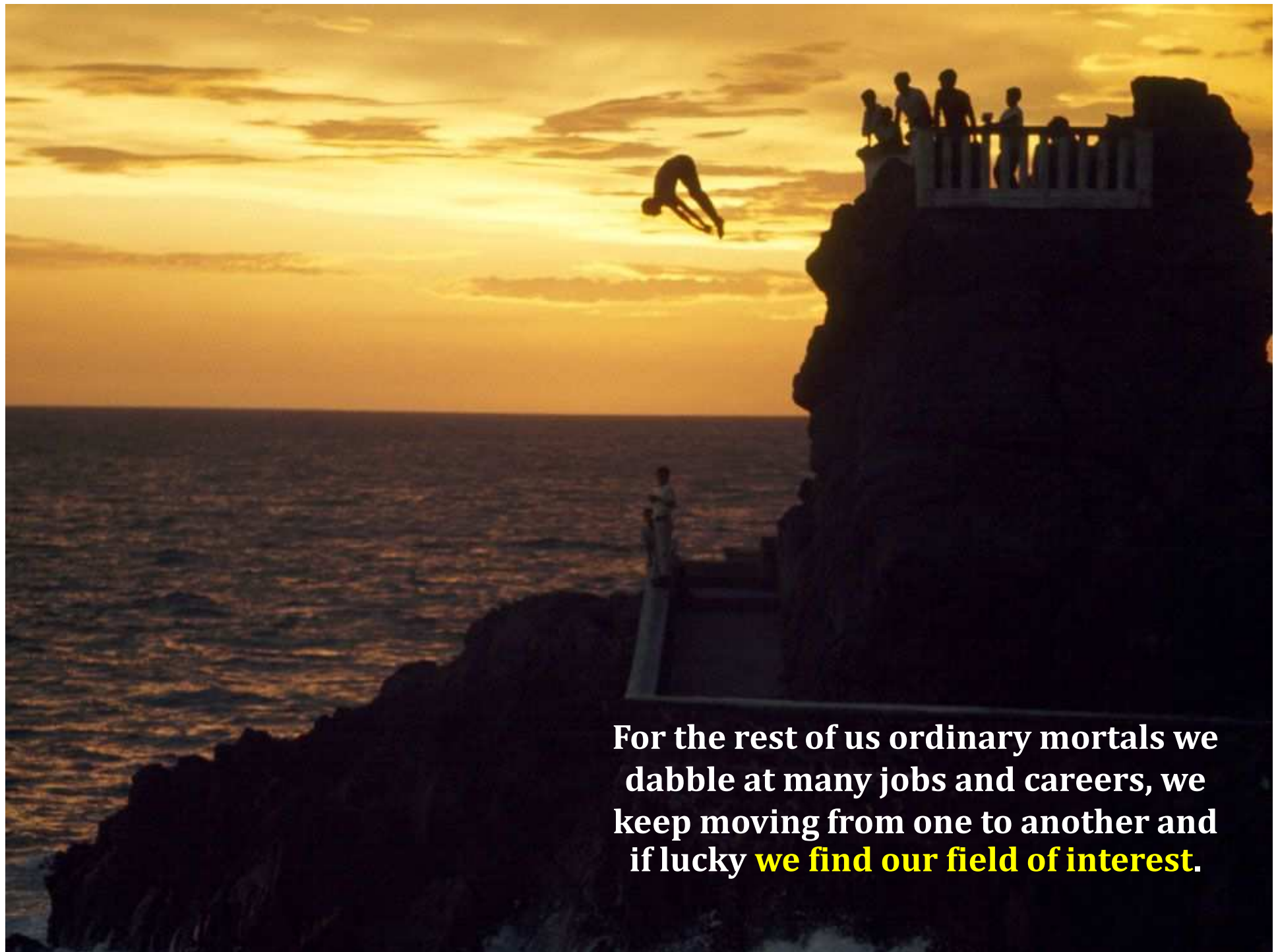


To succeed in any field

a strong interest.

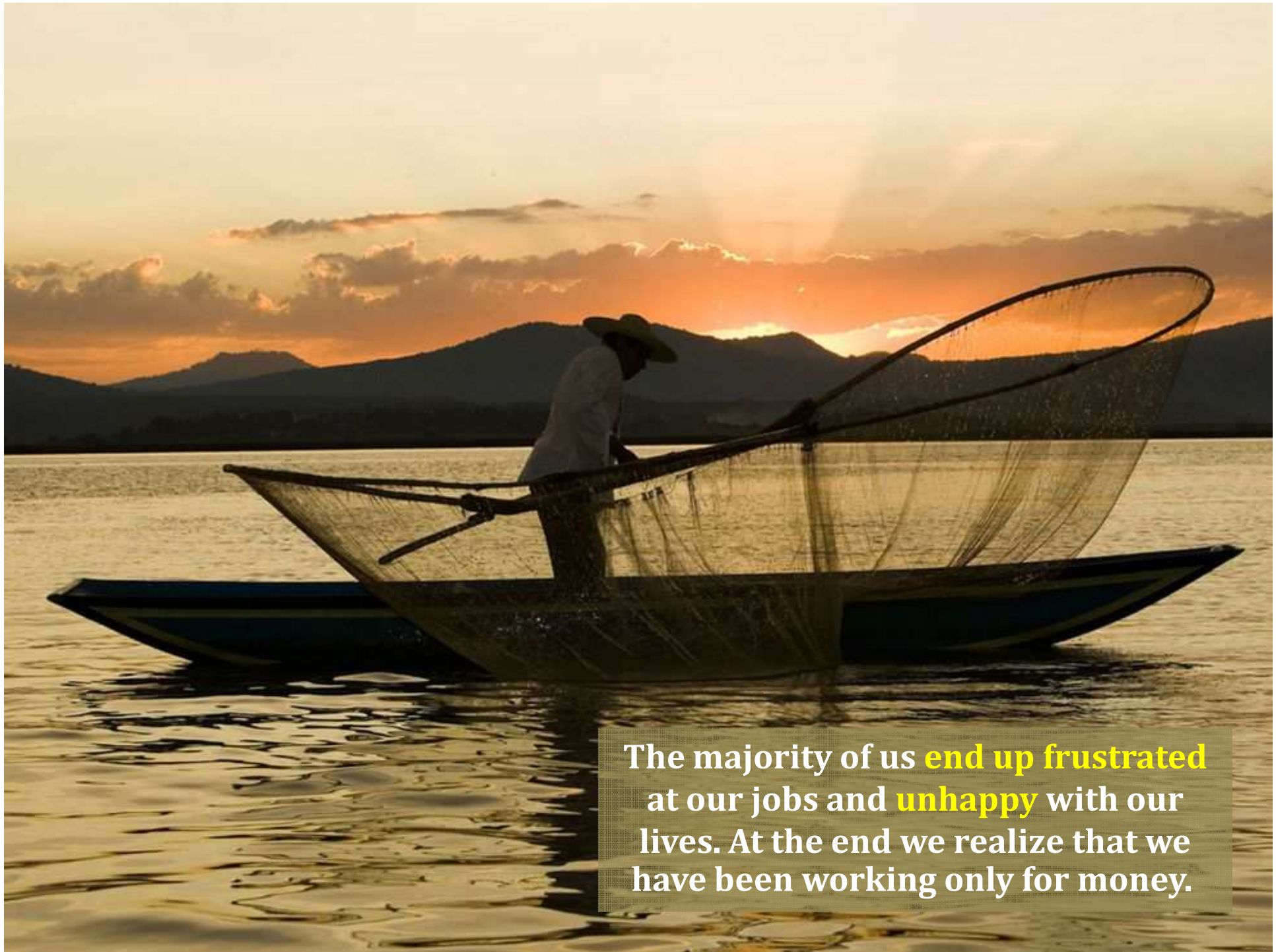

You should **choose your interests over money**. With a burning desire you can reach to the top of your chosen field and money will have no choice but to follow you.

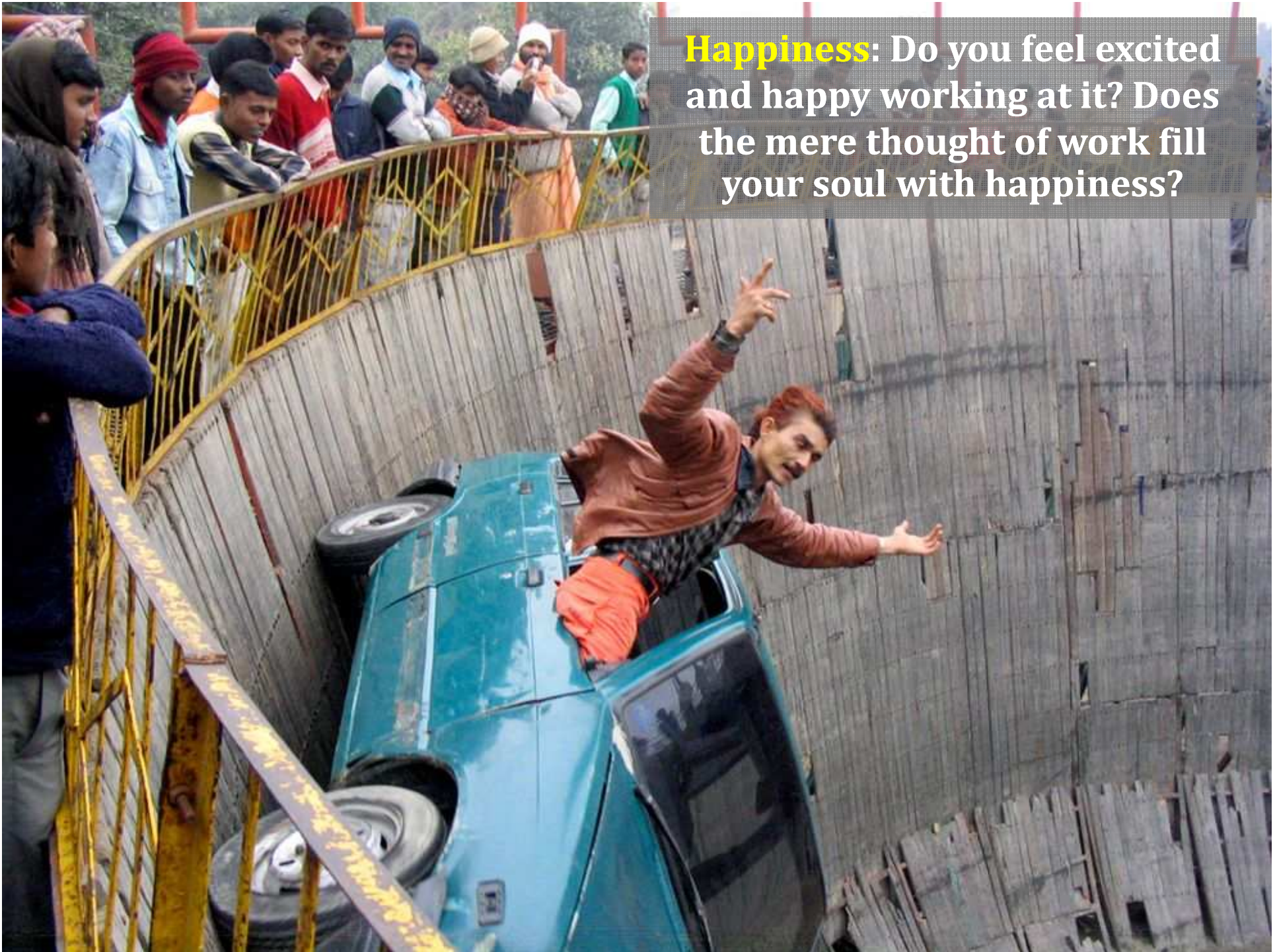

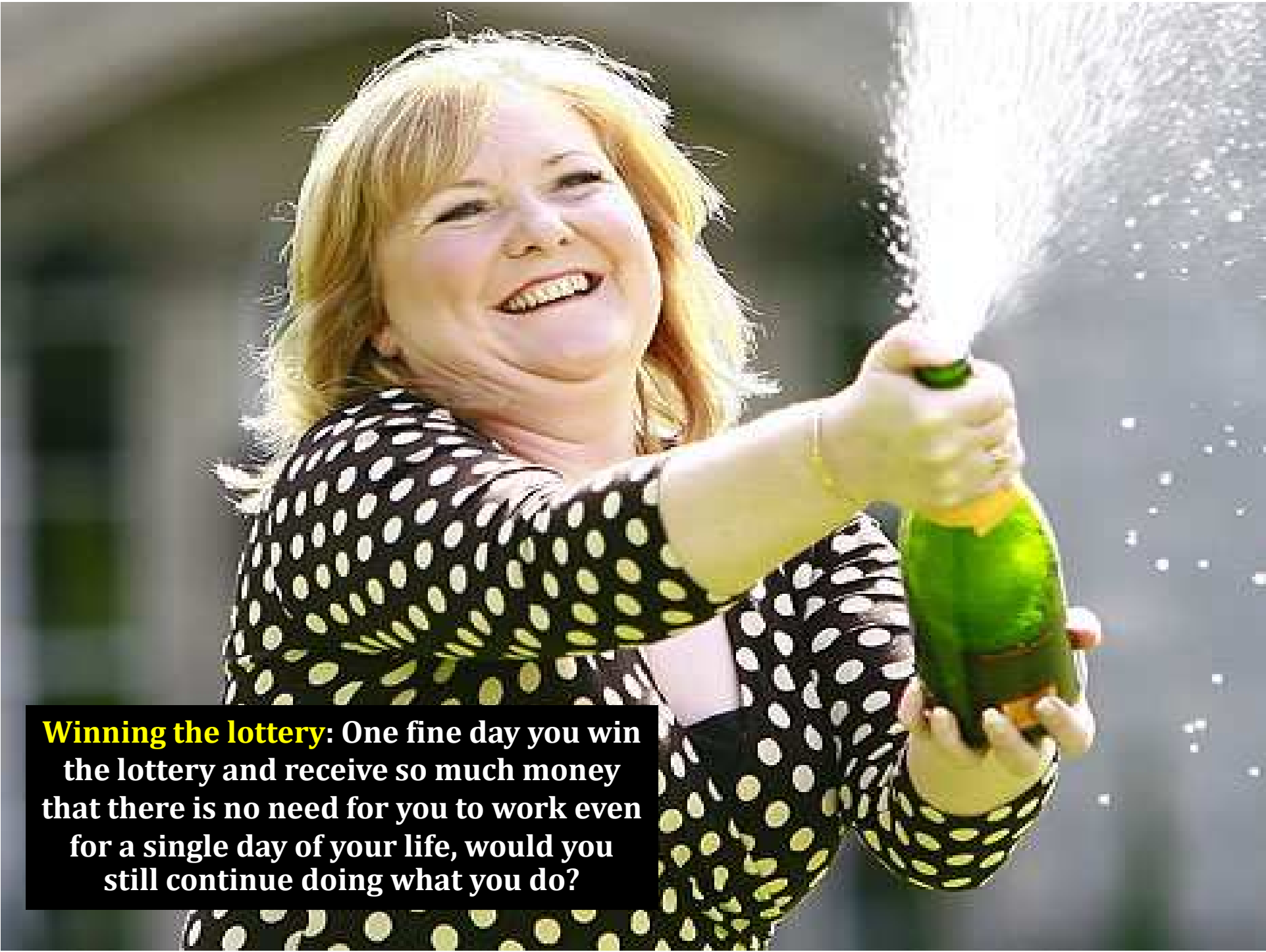
Genuine passion and strong desire

Contentment: After completing the work/job do you get the same contentment and happiness that you get after having sex.



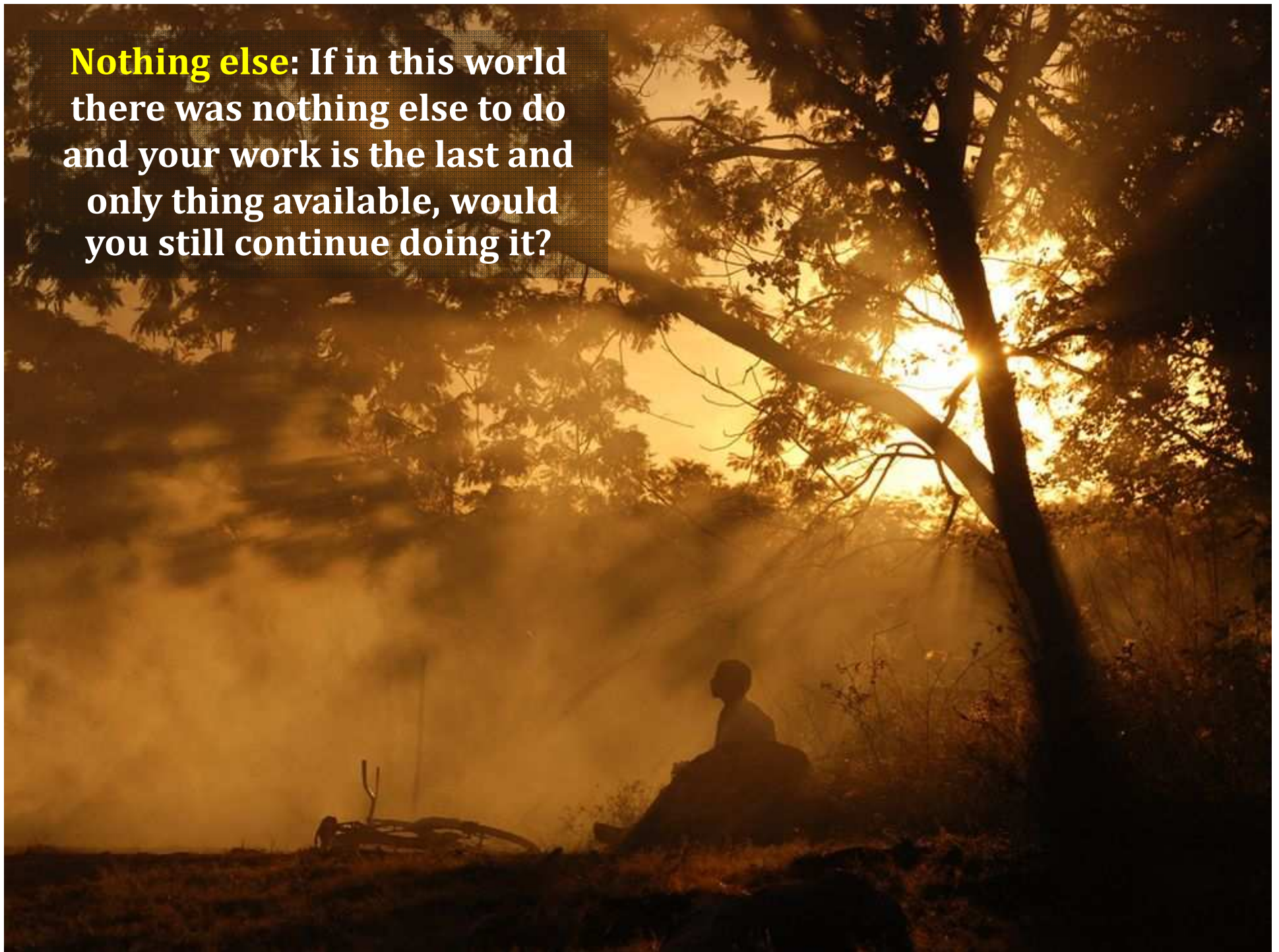
Free of cost: Would you do it for free without any money? Would you do it just for the love of it even if no one paid you a single penny?

Nothing else: If in this world there was nothing else to do and your work is the last and only thing available, would you still continue doing it?



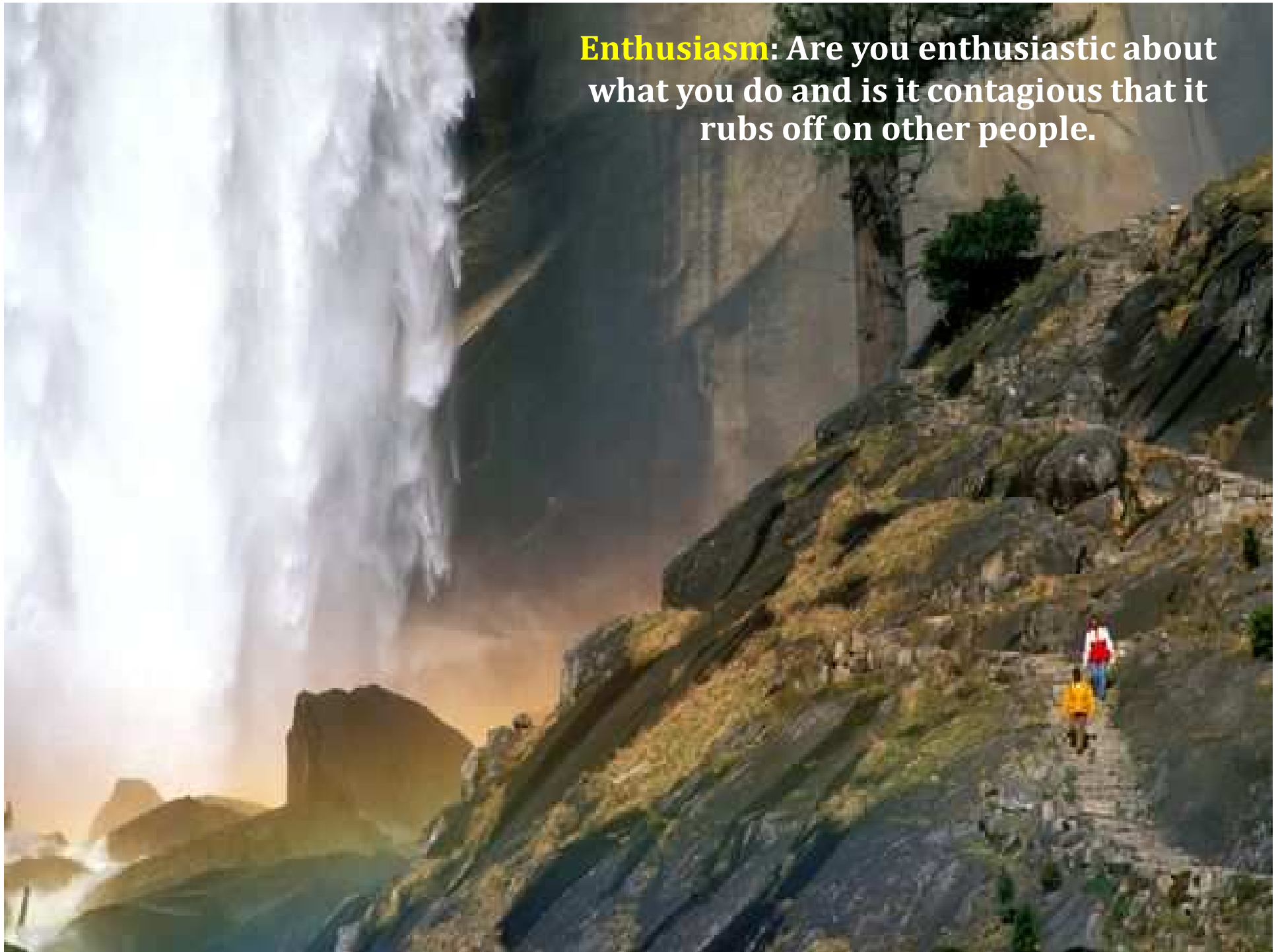


Love: You are so in love with

Completely Destroyed: If all that you created and achieved in your field of work was completely destroyed, will you start all over again with the same zeal and fervor?



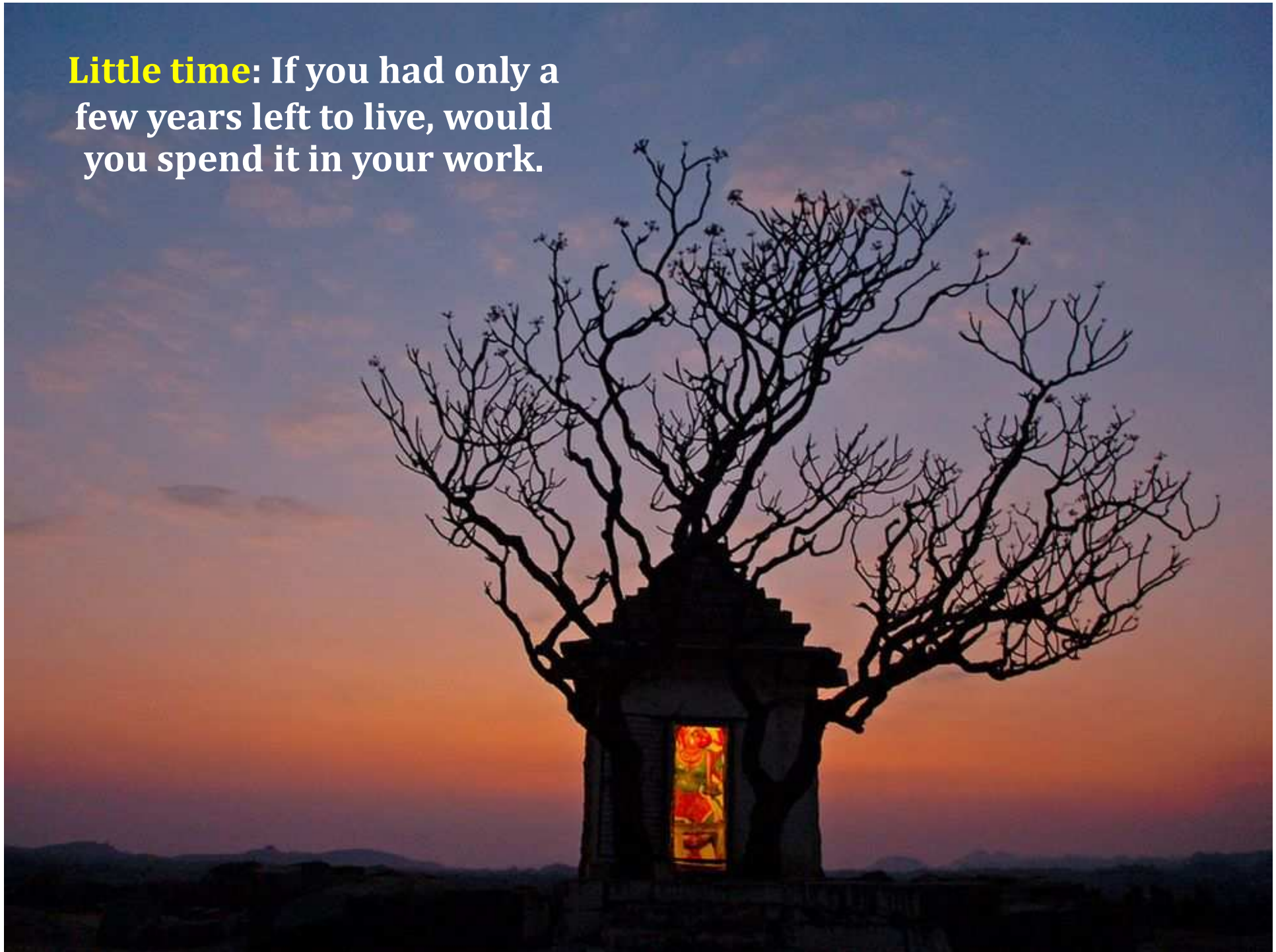
Enthusiasm: Are you enthusiastic about what you do and is it contagious that it rubs off on other people.
