

IAS exam is the toughest in written exam as well as in interview. Few candidates can crack the written exam, but they fail in interview. Many reason behind that, but recruitmentresult.com gives a collection of IAS Interview questions which are asked by IAS Toppers. It will reduce one reason that lack of knowledge of candidates.

Some examples of questions of IAS Toppers Interview:

Q. A person has certain number of cows and birds. They have 172 eyes and 344 legs. How many cows and birds does he have?

A. Each Cow has 2 eyes and 4 legs and each bird has 2 eyes and 2 legs. Let's call each eye as x and each leg as y. Also each bird is n and each cow is m so:

$$n(2x+2y) + m(2x + 4y) = 172x + 344y$$

$$2x (n+m) + 2y(n+2m) = 172x + 344y$$

$$(n+m) = 86 \text{ and } (n+2m) = 172$$

$$n = 86 - m$$

$$86 - m + 2m = 172 \text{ or } m = 86$$

This implies $n = 0$.

The owner has 0 birds and 86 cows.

Q. Suppose 8 monkeys take 8 minutes to eat 8 bananas. (a) How many minutes would it take 3 monkeys to eat 3 bananas? (b) How many monkeys would it take to eat 48 bananas in 48 minutes?

A. (a) 8 Minutes because each monkey takes 8 minutes to eat a banana

(b) 8 Monkeys are required to eat 48 bananas in 48 minutes. Each monkey will eat 6 bananas.

Q. A man builds a house with four sides of rectangular construction, each side having a southern exposure. A big bear comes along. What color is the bear?

A. White

Q. A farmer had 17 sheep. All but 9 died. How many live sheep were left?

A. 9 live sheep

Q. Some months have 30 days, some months have 31 days. How many months have 28 days?

A. All of them. Every month has 28 days.
