Please provide your complete address with phone number and e-mail id along with recent photograph. Please give your name on the back of the photograph.
 - Registration fee: Rs.500 per student for those registering till 8/8/2008 (Rs. 150 per day extra for outstation students i.e. Rs.800 for 2 days or Rs,950 for 3 days , Outstation delegates are advised to confirm their participation latest by 31st July,2008 for accommodation arrangement) & Rs.550/- for students joining after 8/8/2008.
 - Demand Draft to be drawn in favour of "Institute Chartered Accountants of India, EIRC", payable at 'Kolkata'. Delegate fee can be paid in cash only in case of submission in Person (not through Post / Courier) at EIRC office with effect from 16th June 2008 during office hours

on working days (Monday to Friday excepting holidays). Students joining for the programme would get their delegate certificate at the end of the Convention.
