Course Objectives

Traditional Accounting to FA Software

Professional Accountants have migrated from the traditional systems of accounting (Bahi Khatas) to accounting software like Tally, Busy, EX considering immense benefits with tallied accounts. In addition to accounting, organizations typically use Payroll, Production Planning, Inventory Management, Sales Management etc. applications to manage their operations. These are generally disjointed applications requiring entries to be passed manually amongst each other, to reflect the status of operations. Many organizations also get software developed and implemented in these areas suiting their needs, but have difficulty in adopting to newer requirements considering cost, time and design constraints.

ERP – An Introduction

ERP is a software application designed to enable enterprises derive competitive advantage in production, distribution and financial/

accounting areas. It is an integrated suite of application software modules providing operational, managerial & strategic information for improving productivity, quality & competitiveness. Enterprises implement ERP application to achieve desired objective of staying globally competitive is achieved by ERP as an integrated business process of the organization. ERP software help enterprises manage their business better by providing the much required MIS.

ERP – Modules

ERP systems generally come in Modules – Finance/ Control/ Sales & Distribution (SD)/ Materials Management/ Supplier Chain Management (SCM)/ Customer Relationship Management (CRM)/ Human resource Management (HR)/ Production Planning (PP). Enterprises can choose to implement some modules to begin with and add others down the line. In addition, they have Business Intelligence (BI) tools to generate information/reports. It is a codification of industry best practices.

ERP – Implementations

The ERP modules come with basic facilities and features, which have to be customized at the time of implementation and maintenance to enable enterprises to better manage their operations considering their specific requirements.

Each ERP implementations has its own strengths and weaknesses in specific areas, volume of transactions and segments (Large/ Medium/ Small).

ERP - Business Intelligence Tools

ERP implementations have a Business Intelligence Tools to generate required reports which may also include graphs for typical reporting requirements, apart from the standard reports built in the system.

Faculty

Microsoft India would be deputing experienced faculty with implementation experience to provide the necessary academic/ technical/ mentoring support.

Fin-II & Fin-III Modules

Participants may join Fin-II and Fin-III modules of 2.5 and 2 days respectively sat proportionate additional fees.

Certification

Microsoft India would reimburse Rs.3, 000/- plus certification fee of Rs.2, 000/- (approx) to candidates who qualify the certification examination after completing Fin-I, Fin-II and Fin-III modules.

Who can join?

This course has been started for ISA Members considering their demand for practical training and ICAI Members. Institute final students or those who have completed their articles can also join.
