

# 10 Exam Tips For Be Different.....

Hummmm.....Wondering how to appear for Professional exam...?????????

Just check out following 10 Fundas for Professional Exam That Will Make A Difference.....

1) First and important, make your answers look professional. Give a best impression of what you know about the subject while answering the question .**Communicate your knowledge** of 6 months or more studies to the examiner in three hours. Answer the exam in your best handwriting and language. Both speed and accuracy are important.

- 2) **Listen carefully** what is requirement of question and your answer. To write down whole story about question is not needed. When students read the question the important consideration should be what the examiner wants to know about the subject. Just check out few typical key words and phrases given by examiner



Explain in detail....

- Prove that....
- What is your opinion about....
- Write short note on....
- Discuss in detail....
- Discuss in brief.....
- How would you explain.....?
- Difference between.....and.....
- Compare....with...
- Describe....
- Explain not more than one sentence.

Examiners have their own ways of drafting questions. It is the little catches in the

wording that matter lots. Look for key words. It is for you to understand what the examiner really demands through question. This is possible only when you read & understand the questions correctly and patiently.

3) Do **not write filler sentences** i.e. sentences Just to fill the page. Concentrate on the quality and not on the quantity what you write. Filler sentences do not fetch any marks.

- 4) Write down formulas, facts or other materials you know. **Relate your answer** with various aspects of other subjects also, that is needed for professional exams that you have all-round knowledge about the subject.
- 5) Make sure that your answers are represented by **correct question numbers**. Some students are making drastic mistakes in this regard and losing the marks. The answer to each new question must be commenced on fresh page.
- 6) The easiest strategy is to start with the question with which you are **most comfortable**. This will give a sense of confidence. It will make a good first impression on the paper checker. Make sure that you get the best mark in it.
- 7) If you are hang up in the middle of the answer due to temporary memory lapse, leave **appropriate space blank** and go on to the next question from the beginning of the next page. If during attempting next question or questions you remember some point relating to previous question, add the same to the previous question.
- 8) **Write as much as possible** on each question .Remembering that you will get marks only for what you write and not for what is in your head. Remember your question paper itself have many of answers just keep smart watch on that.
- 9) Keep an **eye on the time and marks** allocated for each question. Write as clearly as possible, but without reducing your speed.
- 10) If you finish the paper early, use the time to **edit your work**. Also check that you have answered all the questions by circling the tick marks made by you in the question paper. **Give 10 minutes** for underline important points, making lines after each answer, highlight heading of notes, draw & close the columns of answer.
