

Powers Vested In Company Law Board

- 104(4B) To authorize formation of one or more benches from among its members.
- 17(2) To confirm alteration in memorandum of association as to change place of registered office
from one state to another or with respect to objects of a company.
- 18(4) To extend time for filling of documents or for registration of alteration.
- 43 To grant relief to a private company from consequence of accidental failure to comply with conditions constituting it a private company.
- 49(10) To direct an immediate inspection of register of investment if inspection is refused.
- 58A(9) To take cognizance of any case of non- payment of deposits and to direct repayment of such deposits forth with in specified time subject to certain conditions.
- 80A(1) To give consent to issue of further redeemable preference shares in lieu of irredeemable shares.
- 79(2) To sanction issue of shares at a discount.
