- **How much does the ICAI Service Tax e-Learning cost?**

- **How do I pay to access the Service Tax e-Learning course?**

- **Does just paying ICAI enable me to access the e-Learning course material?**
No. When your payment process is completed with ICAI, you will receive a welcome e-mail from ICAI. The welcome mail contains your unique "**Redeem Code**". This "Redeem Code" enables you to create your personal e-Learning account.

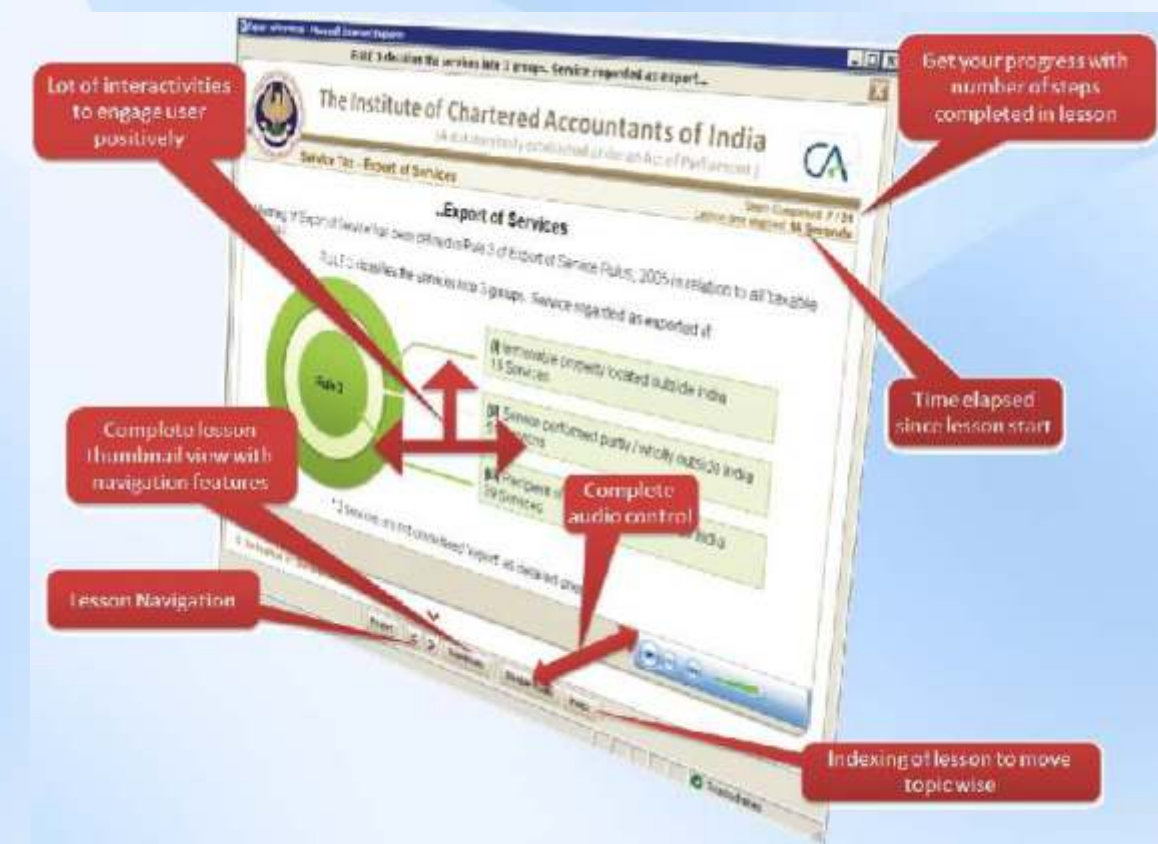

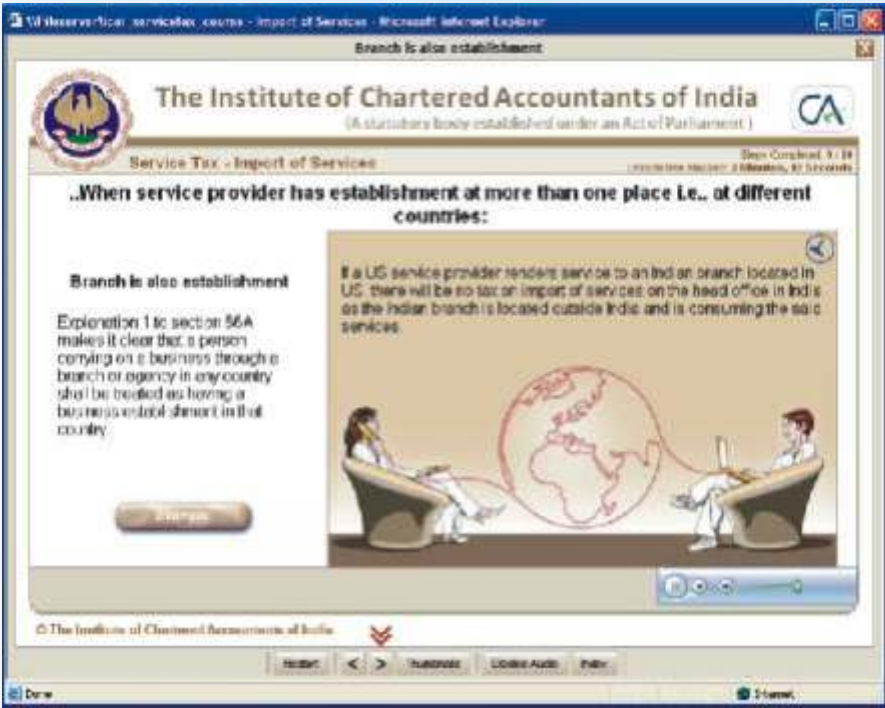
