First Annual General Meeting

The first Annual General Meeting of the West Bengal Regional Council was held on the 22nd September, 1952, with Sri J. Gupta, F.C.A., in the chair. The death of N. K. Majumder and D. Basu, two distinguished members of the profession in this region, was condoled by members standing in silence for two minutes.

The Chairman having read his address, the Secretary read his report and accounts for the first period ended 29th August, 1952 (previously circulated to the members) which were unanimously adopted.

The following Resolutions were passed at the meeting :

1. That this house is of the opinion and recommends to the Central Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India that the portion of Reg. 34 of the C. A. Regulations, 1949, dealing with the refund of premium to the articled clerks, *viz.* "But any premium charged by the employer shall be refunded by him in instalments as the former may deem fit but not later than 14 days after the date of completion of the articles subject to satisfactory service and good conduct of the Articled Clerk" be deleted ;
2. That this meeting fully approves of the action taken by the Central Council in dropping the question of reciprocity.

OF THE

WEST BENGAL REGIONAL COUNCIL

for the period from 31st March to 28th August, 1953

Gentlemen,

We report on the working of the West Bengal Regional Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India since the last General Meeting on the 30th March, 1953.

1. *Regional Council Meetings* :—This Council has met on five occasions. The business transacted included discussions on various professional matters. The General Purposes Committee could not finalise the arrangements for the formation of the "Accountants' Club" owing to the difficulty in securing suitable accommodation for housing the Club.

2. *Coaching Classes* :—The students of our classes have done well in May, 1953 examination. The following is the statistics of the results and the All-India percentage.

3. The students' Section of the West Bengal Regional Council has been formed under the name of "West Bengal Regional Chartered Accountants' Students Association" and the first general meeting of the Association was held on the 22nd August, 1953 when the Rules and Regulations of the Association were adopted and the Executive Committee and Office bearers for the first year were elected.

4. *Activities* :—(a) On the 17th April, 1953, Dr. Nalinaksha Sanyal, M.A., Ph.D. (London), addressed the members of this Region on the FIVE-YEAR PLAN. The lecture was very much appreciated for

the critical analysis of the Scheme and the comparison of the Scheme with similar ones in other countries.

(b) On the 10th June, 1953, a symposium on the First Five-Year Plan was conducted in which Sri B. C. Ghosh, B.Sc., Econ. (London), B.COM. (London) of Calcutta University, M.P., was invited to open the discussion. The Regional Council and the members were very much thankful to the scholarly lecturer for giving them the benefit of his deep study and erudition.

(c) On 8th August, 1953, the members met at a Lunch Party at Prince's Grand Hotel, Calcutta, where the Chief Guest Sri A. V. Viswanatha Sastri, Chairman, Income-tax Investigation Commission, spoke in a very eloquent and instructive manner on the Services the Accountants can render to the country in general and the business community in particular. The distinguished guests included the other two members of the Income-tax Investigation Commission and the Commissioner of Income-tax, West Bengal and Calcutta.

5. The Regional Council is deeply indebted to the Accountants' Library for allowing the Regional Council Meetings to be held there; to the Bengal National Chamber of Commerce for giving their Hall for the meetings of the members of the Institute in this Region and to the Anglo-Gujrati School for allowing the Coaching Classes to be held in the School premises.

6. Our special thanks are due to Messrs. S. & Batliboi & Co., Chartered Accountants, Honorary Auditors, for the prompt attention they gave for the audit of our accounts. According to the Bye-law No. 28 of the Regional Councils, they retire, but are eligible for re-election.

Item Introduction of Best Study Circle Award

Item No.3: To discuss and finalise the date for laying foundation stone of the proposed building project at Hatisur near the crossing of EM Bye Pass & Kasha-Connector

The Chairman placed his letter dated 22nd December 2004 addressed to Mr. Sunil Goyal, President of the ICAI inviting him to lay the foundation stone of the new Building of ICAI near the crossing of EM Bye Pass & Kasha Connector on Monday, the 31st January 2005. He informed that he had detailed discussions with the President, ICAI and as desired by the President, he subsequently submitted him, vide his letter dated 1st January 2005, the Projected Fund Flow of the new Building and the draft resolution of the relevant proceedings taken up in the 6th meeting of EIRC of ICAI held in Guwahati on 17.12.2004.

(a) Contribution of EIRC to Tsunami Fund

The Chairman informed that employees of ICAI Kolkata donated Rs.10,646/- to the Tsunami Fund. He also informed that as per request of the President in the Institute's Journal, donations for Rs.20,000/- received from the members by the Kolkata Office and the said amount was also sent to Delhi Office.

The Chairman suggested that Rs.30,000/- (i.e. matching amount of donations sent to Delhi by Kolkata Office) be donated from the Regional Council Fund. The Central Council Members informed that no amount could be donated from the Regional Fund to Tsunami Project. However, the members could donate individually. The members present appreciated the members of this region and employees of ICAI, Kolkata Office for contributing to the Tsunami Fund.

Item No.6: To discuss procurement of additional land for ICAI, EIRC Building.

The Chairman informed the members that the President, Chairman, EIRC & Others met Shri Ashok Bhattacharya, Minister-in-Charge of Urban Development & Municipal Affairs, Govt. of West Bengal and thereafter the Chief Executive Officer of CMDA regarding procurement of additional land for the ICAI Building. Both the Minister and the CEO, CMDA have assured allotment of land for the Institute to the extent of one acre, if possible at an institutional price.

(b) To discuss the question of introduction of Hindi as an alternative language to English in the C.A. Examinations.
Shri N.K.Poddar was requested to report back the outcome of his dialogues with the Hindi Committee in regard to the above matter and he briefly explained the position in the matter. Thereafter long discussions followed and at the end it was unanimously decided that all the Central Council members be requested to send a telegram to the Secretary of the Institute requesting the Council to reconsider the matter relating to introduction of Hindi as alternative to English in the C.A.Examination and consider this matter as a separate item in the agenda at the ensuing Council Meeting to be held in April. It was also decided that a suitable letter in this regard be also sent to the President of the Institute, under the signature of all the Central Council Members of this Region. It was further decided that Shri Bhaskar Banerjee may prepare the initial draft of the aforesaid letter and finalise the same in consultation with Shri N.K.Poddar.



Inauguration of EIRC Building

Speech of Shri A.L. Dias, Governor of West Bengal, at the inauguration of the new building of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, Eastern India Regional Council on April 14, 1977.

Mr. Maheswari, Mr. Das, Ladies and Gentlemen,

I must thank the Eastern India Regional Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India for inviting me to inaugurate the Institute's new building in Calcutta. It is always a pleasure to be in the midst of an eminent professional group such as yours.

I was going through yesterday, with a lot of interest, the informative literature on the Institute which Mr. Das was good enough to send for my perusal. I had of course known of the high professional standing of your Institute but I must confess that I had no idea of the wide range of activities which the Institute conducted on a continuing basis. Apart from the conventional role of conducting examinations, granting certificates and exercising disciplinary jurisdiction, you have been engaged in holding seminars and conferences, in circulating news letters for keeping your members abreast on the state of the art, and in undertaking research activities. The learning process is never ending and the Institute's recognition of this wholesome principle is evident from its varied activities.

Much has been written and said in recent times about the social responsibilities of Chartered Accountants. I have no desire on this occasion to launch into a discussion on this subject. I find that as a professional body your Institute is well aware of its role in both ensuring a high degree of skill among your members and instilling into them the need for observing the highest ethical standards. It is needless to say that in the job that your members perform integrity is no less important than knowledge and skill.

The corporate structure in the country has gained in strength and undergone a remarkable change over the last 25 years. A massive investment has gone into the public and private sectors. Public financing institutions today play an extremely important role in financing

industry and commerce. In the backdrop of the qualitative change that all this signifies the domain of the chartered accountants' responsibility today extends far beyond the limited role of acting as the watchdog of shareholders' interests.

The pitimum utilisation of scare resources—whether material, financial or skilled manpower—deployed in industry is the surest and quickest means of bringing about improvements in the living standards of the people. A 1974-75 study by the Reserve Bank of 1650 companies shows that 54 per cent of the total cost of production is accounted for by raw materials. Stores and spares account for 1.39 per cent, power and fuel 4.19 per cent, and other manufacturing expenses come to 5.84 per cent. The wage bill by comparison accounts for only 7.74 per cent of the total cost. Quite obviously, if the problem of rising production costs is to be effectively tackled, economy would have to start from the raw material component. The constraints, at least in the short-run, in effecting substantial economy in the cost of raw materials especially those which are agriculture based are well-known. Modern methods of production and improved management of men, machinery and material would therefore seem to be the only effective means of bringing down the input cost. And the Reserve Bank's study does confirm the scope for improvements in this regard. This is the big challenge before managers, accountants, engineers and technicians, and of course, labour.

I have been impressed by the research activities of your Institute. The Government and others who have an interest in the matter immensely benefit, I am sure, from your suggestions and recommendations flowing from research. In fact, I strongly feel that the scope of your research activities might be profitably widened.

There has been a phenomenal growth in the size of the public sector in recent times. The complexities of financial management in public sector undertakings have increased manifold but there is a feeling that there has not been adequate study and reform of the accounting systems which are followed and some of which are antiquated. There is no doubt that the accounting systems followed in these organisations must be made more relevant and responsible to present day needs and must graduate from mere accountability to programme management in all its positive aspects.

I have referred earlier to the increasingly important role of public financial institutions. In some cases unfortunately the rate of default in repayment has reached alarming proportions. The public has a stake here and cannot but feel concerned over such developments. What are the effective information and monitoring systems that can give timely signal of coming failures so that remedial action may be taken? What are the tools of

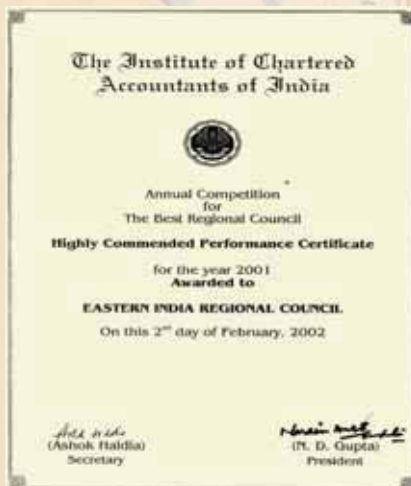
