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RULES FOR THE ELIGIBILITY COMPETITION (KOCHI) FOR THE 13TH ALL INDIA QUIZ COMPETITION

1. Interested students may enroll their team of not more than 2 members before July 03, 2013, Wednesday by submitting the duly filled registration forms, attached herewith. Students may also enroll individually who will then be teamed at the venue.
2. The competition will be in 3 rounds namely (i) “*nitty-gritty*” covering the basics of Company Law (ii) “*Relevare*” covering most relevant sections and MCA updates (iii) “*Omnis*” covering the entire Company Law. For each correct answer, the team will be given +10, for wrong answer -5. In the event of tie, the tie will be resolved with a tie breaker question. The questions not answered by one team will be passed on to the next team.
3. The competition shall be in English. Participants are requested to read the rules carefully. Incomplete registration forms will not be accepted.
4. Eligibility to participate is only to registered students of ICSI. Practising Advocates, Chartered Accountants, Cost Accountants are not eligible to participate. A student who has qualified in the final/professional programme examination is not eligible to participate in the contest.
5. The questions will be on Companies Act, 1956 and the circulars / notifications / guidelines issued by MCA. The questions may be subjective or objective, written or oral.
6. The winning team from the chapter level competition (Kochi) will represent the Kochi Chapter of ICSI and will be eligible to participate in the Regional Level competition to be held on Friday, the 12th July, 2013 at 3.00 p.m. at “ICSI-SIRC House”, No.9, Wheat Crofts Road, Nungambakkam, Chennai – 600 034.
7. The winning team comprising of not more than two students in each Region will be participating in the National Level event to be held on Friday, the 26th July, 2013 at Chennai.
8. The travel expenses of the students (limited to 2 students) shall be borne by the Chapter.
9. No registration fees is required for participation in the programme
10. The decision of the judges regarding the allocation of the marks will be final and no arguments will be allowed during the currency of the contest.
