South Asian Federation of Accountants (SAFA) was formed in the year 1984 to serve the accountancy profession in the South Asian Region and uphold its eminence in the world of accountancy. SAFA is an Apex Body of the South Asian Association for Regional Co-operation (SAARC) and Acknowledged Accounting Grouping of International Federation of Accountants (IFAC). SAFA represents over 300000 accountants having membership of the national chartered accountancy and cost and management accountancy institutions in the South Asian countries namely Bangladesh, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. SAFA came into existence at the initiative of the accounting professional bodies in the South Asian Region, which has a bond of culture and homogeneity of professional environment.

About ICAI

The Institute of Cost Accountants of India (ICAI) was first established in 1944 as a registered company under the Companies Act with the objects of promoting, regulating and developing the profession of Cost Accountancy. On 28th May, 1959, the Institute was set up by an act of Parliament, namely, the Cost and Works Accountants Act, 1959 as a statutory professional body for the regulation of the profession of cost and management accountancy. It has since been continuously contributing to the growth of the industrial and economic climate of the country. The Institute of Cost Accountants of India is the only statutory professional body in India specialising exclusively in Cost and Management Accountancy.

The head office of the Institute is situated at Kolkata with four regional offices at Kolkata, Chennai, Delhi and Mumbai as well as 94 chapters situated elsewhere in India and 9 overseas centers abroad. The Institute comes under the administrative control of Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA), Government of India. It has more than 60000 members and 450000 students.

The objectives of the Institute is to develop the Cost and Management Accountancy function as a powerful tool of management control in all spheres of economic activities, promote and develop the adoption of scientific methods in cost and management accountancy, develop the professional body of members and equip them fully to discharge their functions and fulfill the objectives of the Institute in the context of the developing economy, keep abreast of the latest developments in the cost and management accounting principles and practices and to incorporate such changes that are essential for sustained vitality of the industry and other economic activities.

About Bhubaneswar

The history of the city stretches back over 2000 years. The area first appears as the ancient capital of Kalinga. Bhubaneswar, the 'city of temples', named after Tribhuvaneswar, 'Lord of Three Worlds', still preserves over 500 of India's finest temples like Lingaraj Temple, Sun Temple and Shanti Stupa at Dhauligiri (Buddhist temple) etc. around which the religious life of the city revolves. Together with Puri and Konark, Bhubaneswar forms the 'golden triangle'-- one of the most visited destinations in East India, for its proud possession of magnificent sculpture and majestic architectural heritage. Asia's largest brackish water lagoon Chilka Lake is also nearby. Bhubaneswar is located on the coastal plains of Odisha (Orissa), south-west of the River Mahanadi. The summer months from March to May are hot and humid, and temperatures often shoot past 40° C in May. Pleasant weather conditions prevail during November in Bhubaneswar, but December and January face the chilly winds from the North North-east at average speeds of 7 miles/hour. Temperatures drop to approximately 15° C during these months.

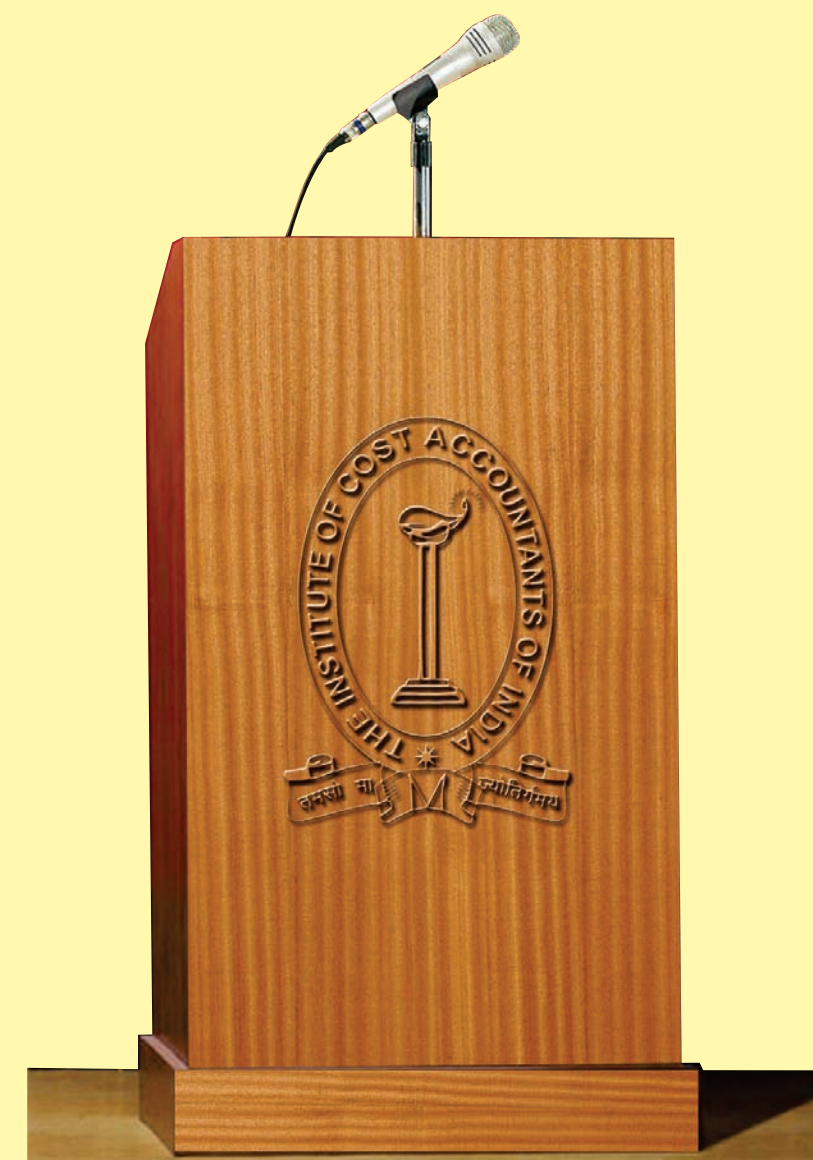

Integrated Reporting demonstrates linkages between strategies, governance and performance reflecting Economic, Social and Environmental aspects. This approach provides the stakeholders with a holistic view of the business.

An integrated report aims to provide insight about the resources and relationships used and affected by an organization – these are collectively referred to as “the capitals” in the IR Framework. It also seeks to explain how the organization interacts with the external environment and the capitals to create value over the short, medium and long term.
