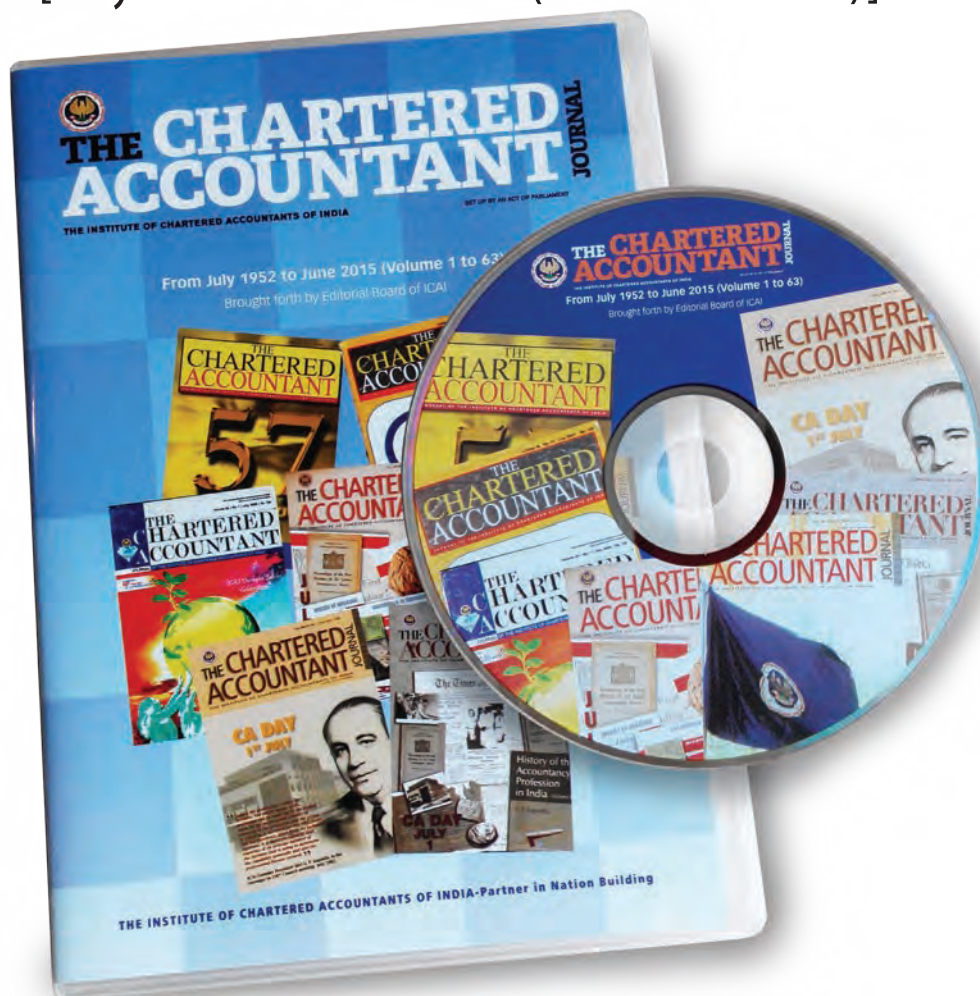

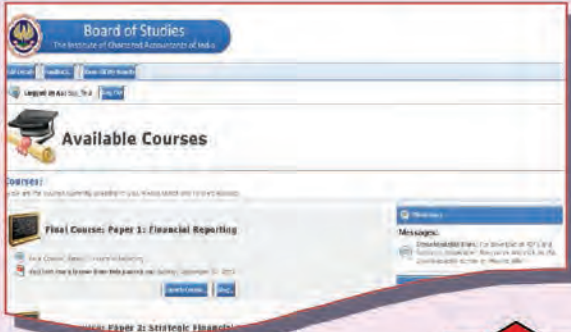

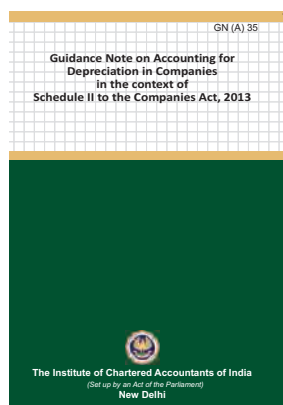

GN (A) 35 Guidance Note on Accounting for Depreciation in Companies in the context of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013 (Issued 2016)

The Council of the Institute has brought out 'Guidance Note on Accounting for Depreciation in Companies in the context of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013'. This Guidance Note provides guidance on certain significant issues that may arise from the practical application of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013 with a view to establish consistent practice with regard to the accounting for depreciation.

This Guidance Note becomes applicable for accounting periods beginning on or after 1st April, 2016; its earlier application is encouraged.
