Note 1 – Q2 RTP – Forex

- Remember exchange rates are in Reverse Convention. GBP/INR 99.10 means the asset is GBP and Price is INR, and the rate should be read as follows
“99.10 Rupees for 1 unit of Pound”
- Out of 6, 1st, 3rd and 5th is Direct Quote and 2nd, 4th & 6th is their indirect quotes.
- 5th and 6th is not the exact reverse of each other. This might be deliberate thing or the mistake.
