

Way to Pass CA Exam whether it is Foundation/Inter/Final

Thinking process on

What to read, how to read, how much read.

Every Students have these types of questions in their mind and anxiety also exist.

I will share some suggestion to crack your exam.

1. Planning
2. Execution
3. Commitment
4. Dedication

The first two are much important to pass CA Examination.

A student first plan their subject and also the capabilities to execute the same. In Planning of particular subject, you have to summarize the syllabus first and identify the important chapter and then select the important topic and cover them.

How to make a plan-

- First make monthly plan (Spent day 1 or 2 for perfect planning)
- Divide that in Weekly
- Then in a day (hourly basis)
- I am 100% sure

Start with a 6 hours day schedule and increase it thereafter and go upto 14 to 15 hrs per day. Start with subjects which are interesting for you and that help you to increase your study hours. Studying 2 – 3 subjects in a day is better than stretching one all day, it will help you to sit longer. I make notes to keep myself interested in the subject for long hours, you can also try making notes, charts, it will also give clarity and help you to retain the topic for a long time.

Most important point is you should always keep testing yourself with random question-solving. For example, if you studied a topic yesterday then today you can randomly pick a question from that topic and solve it without seeing its answer and further please check yourself while studying one subject, ask yourself any concept from another subject if you will give answer then there will be chance to clear the exam.

In this way you can see how much you have retained as well as it is a good way to boost your confidence
