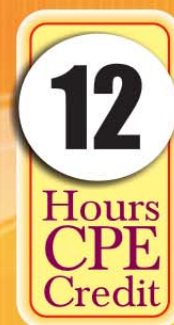

Dear Member,

Warm Greetings to you and your family.

I have great pleasure in inviting you to TECHNOLOGY SUMMIT 2009, the First National IT Conference on 26th and 27th June 2009 at Hotel Le-Meridian Bangalore. We have invited leading IT experts across the country to share their valuable experience and update members on the developments taking place in the exciting world of information technology. This Summit is the first in the series of five National IT Conferences being conducted across the country.

The Committee on Information Technology has been established by the Institute to identify Information Technology challenges facing the profession and convert them into gainful professional opportunities for members by conducting Conferences, Seminars, Practical Workshops, Training programmes and to provide Practice Guides, Training Aids, Softwares and Publications on Information Technology for the benefit of members.

I am pleased to highlight some of the recent innovative initiatives of the Committee on Information Technology :

- 1. Project Parivartan (Improving e-governance in ICAI) :** The Committee has conceived Project 'Parivartan' with an idea of taking ICAI to a new way of working that would bring Chartered Accountants and CA students in the country as a CA Pariwar . The goal is to create a single tightly integrated IT system for catering to the entire community of Chartered Accountants and students irrespective of their geographical locations through the Internet. The project has been flagged off on 6th May 2009 and Workshops are being organised at New Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai, Kanpur, Mumbai , Bangalore and Jaipur to get feedback from members and students. This project has been awarded to Infosys Technologies Ltd, a world leader in IT with a mandate to transform ICAI to a world class tech-savvy accounting body in the world.
- 2. IT Directorate:** A full fledged Information Technology (IT) Directorate has been set up to bring all IT activities under one umbrella and to facilitate co-ordination and optimum use of IT resources for the benefit of members and students. The IT Directorate shall synchronise, standardise, optimise and expedite the processes to bring a unified approach towards all IT initiatives such as VIP, Online Exam and Results Processing, Websites & Portals, e-Learning, IT education & training to members and students.
- 3. First National ICAI Webcast on Global Economic Crisis :** The Committee beamed the first National ICAI Webcast on Global Economic Crisis Changing Role of CA's on Friday the 17th April 2009 . The Webcast was inaugurated by CA Uttam Prakash Agarwal, President ICAI and CA Mohandas Pai delivered a special address on the global crisis and more than 4000 members viewed the webcast live from the comfort of their homes and offices. I am delighted to inform you that we have received an excellent response from members across the country and we plan to conduct many more webcasts in future. The Committee has also decided to launch a new ICAI Webcasting channel on 1st July 2009 to commemorate the Diamond Jubilee of ICAI where members can stream videos of experts on various topics of professional interest. Webcasting provides an opportunity for members residing abroad also to view seminars of the Institute live.
- 4. New IT Publications :** The Committee has released two brochures on IT Courses and IT Publications to reach out to members at large. An information booklet on Post Qualification Course on Information System Audit has been published by the Committee to popularise the ISA course. The Committee has also launched three new Publications "Technical Guide on Systems Audit of Stock Brokers", "Technical Guide on Information Systems Audit" and "Data Analysis for Auditors -Practical Case Studies on Using CAATs" to help members develop expertise in these new area.

5. **ISA Meets:** The Committee has organised many ISA Meets across the country to promote interaction amongst 14,000 ISA qualified members on new technology trends. Members having expertise in IS Audit, ERP Implementation and E-Commerce Implementation could share their success stories in these Meets. Many ISA Meets would be conducted across the country for the benefit of ISA members.
6. **Auditors Training Programme on Finacle (Core Banking System) at Infosys Campus, Bangalore:** The Committee successfully organised a pilot residential "Auditors Training Programme on Finacle Core Banking System" with the assistance of Infosys Technologies at Bangalore recently. The Course aims to provide hands-on training to auditors on the basic use of Finacle and also the use of its audit and control features. Similar Courses would be launched in other locations to help members conduct Statutory Branch Audit under Core Banking environment effectively.
7. **IT Manager Course for Members in Industry:** The Committee's new initiative to launch an IT Manager Course will help members in Industry to enhance their skill sets and adopt good IT governance practices and procedures in Corporate, Banks and Financial Institutions.
8. **Information Technology Summit 2009:** The Committee is organising a series of Technology Summits in New Delhi, Mumbai, Pune, Jaipur, Kolkata, Chennai and Hyderabad and Bangalore. These Summits provide an opportunity for members to understand various opportunities open to them in the field of Information Systems Audit and other related areas.
9. **International Initiatives:** The Committee facilitated conducting ISA Course for members of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka as per MOU with ICASL. The Post Qualification Course will be popularised in all the 22 foreign chapters of ICAI. Dubai, Abu Dhabi and New York Chapters of ICAI have shown interest to conduct ISA Courses for the benefit of members residing abroad.
10. **MOU with ISACA :** ICAI has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with Information Systems Audit and Control Association, USA to use the IS Audit Standards, Guidelines and Procedures, these Standards would assist members in conducting IS Audits in India.
11. **Revamped Committee Portal:** The Committee has launched its new CIT Portal which is more user friendly & efficient with added features. The portal is developed in Visual Studio 2008 and is equipped with RSS Facility by which users are able to get the latest updates hosted on the site. The new portal has online e-Learning module on IS Security, Cyber Threats & Review. Members can access the Portal from <http://cit.icaai.org>.
12. **Service Tax e-learning Course:** The first e-learning course on Service Tax has been a big success and more than 4500 members have registered for this e-learning course in the last 4 months. On registration a member is provided with an e-learning kit consisting of a Book on Service Tax, video presentation by the author and a Redeem Code. The next e-learning course on IFRS and Transfer Pricing will be launched shortly.
13. **Promotion of XBRL Financial Reporting Language:** The Institute is spearheading the XBRL initiative in India to promote greater use of the new financial reporting language. ICAI is currently establishing an Indian Jurisdiction for XBRL International. The Committee has planned to develop XBRL technology tools to make financial statements XBRL compliant. XBRL Seminars & Conferences will be conducted to promote awareness among the members about the new reporting language since XBRL implementation would be a new professional opportunity and members can assist companies in XBRL filings with various regulators.
14. **e-Room Study Group for accessing knowledge resources:** An e-Room Study Group has been set up at Bangalore to facilitate access to all ICAI knowledge resources such as publications, presentations, seminar materials online under one portal. The Group would review the existing ICAI Online Facility and discuss a strategy to provide e-content to the members.

I would be extremely happy to receive your feedbacks and suggestions to enable us to transform the IT landscape of ICAI. The Committee will continuously work to identify new professional opportunities and also champion the cause for IS Audit in India.
